## Mays Landing Road/Route 73 to be closed for priority repairs to railroad crossing in Winslow, Camden County Closure required to repair sinkhole

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Mays Landing Road/Route 73 will be closed and detoured for priority repairs to a railroad crossing in Winslow, Camden County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, July 1, until 5 p.m. Friday, July 2, Mays Landing Road/Route 73 is scheduled to be closed at the railroad crossing near 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Winslow, Camden County. This will allow crews to complete priority repairs to a sinkhole near the crossing. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detour or plan an alternate route.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
