I-287 northbound lane closures required for emergency deck joint repairs in Morristown Expect heavy congestion or plan alternate route

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the two right lanes on I-287 northbound are closed just north of Exit 36 to CR 510/Morris Avenue for emergency repairs in Morristown, Morris County.

Beginning at approximately 12 noon today, the two right lanes on I-287 northbound were closed just north of Exit 36 to CR 510/Morris Avenue in Morristown. This closure will allow NJDOT's Contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, to complete emergency deck joint and concrete repairs. The lane closures are expected to continue through the evening commute. Work is expected to be completed overnight. Motorists should expect heavy congestion and may want to consider using an alternate route.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
