Route 18 northbound lane closures required for emergency sinkhole repairs in East Brunswick Two of three lanes are closed

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on Route 18 northbound for emergency repairs in East Brunswick, Middlesex County.

Beginning at approximately 2:30 p.m. this afternoon, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., closed the two left lanes on Route 18 northbound just south of Eggers Street/South Woodland Avenue in East Brunswick for emergency sinkhole repairs. The closure is anticipated to remain in place through the evening commute. One lane of northbound traffic is being maintained.
