Route 35 northbound overnight lane closures required next week for priority milling and paving in Point Pleasant Beach One lane of traffic will be maintained overnight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 35 northbound next week for priority milling and paving in Point Pleasant Beach, Ocean County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. Monday, July 26 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, July 27, and continuing each night through Wednesday, July 28, NJDOT's Contractor, Earle Asphalt Co., is scheduled to close one lane on Route 35 northbound in Point Pleasant Beach for milling and paving. One lane of northbound traffic will be maintained overnight.

The work is part of a larger \$10.6 million state-funded contract to maintain various roadways in Monmouth, Ocean, and Mercer counties.
