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Route 3 lane closures required for emergency concrete repairs in North Bergen Closures will continue through Friday morning

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced several days of lane closures on Route 3 for emergency concrete repairs in North Bergen, Hudson County.

Beginning at approximately 1 p.m. Tuesday, July 27, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, Inc., closed the left lane on Route 3 eastbound near the I-495 interchange. This closure is required to install temporary shielding underneath the overpass to protect vehicles from loose concrete. Following the completion of installation in the left lane, the left lane will reopen and the right lane on Route 3 eastbound will be closed Wednesday evening.

Additional lane closures will be required on Route 3 westbound beginning Thursday morning, with the left lane being closed first, followed by a right lane and shoulder closure beginning later Thursday afternoon. At least one lane of traffic will remain open at all times, and the ramps from Route 3 to I-495 also will remain open while work is taking place. The closures are anticipated to continue through 8 a.m. Friday, July 30.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
