Route 206/Eggert Crossing Road intersection to be paved Thursday and Friday in Lawrence Township, Mercer County Intersection will remain open during paving

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced daytime milling and paving on Route 206 at the Eggert Crossing Road intersection in Lawrence Township, Mercer County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, August 26 until 3 p.m. and continuing again Friday, August 27 during the same hours, NJDOT's contractor, Konkus Corp., is scheduled to mill and pave the Route 206/Eggert Crossing Road intersection. The intersection will remain open while work is taking place, however motorists should expect delays and congestion in the area during working hours.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
