Route 35 northbound lane closure begins tomorrow for utility work in Woodbridge Middlesex Water Company will install a new water main

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced an overnight lane closure on Route 35 northbound in Woodbridge, Middlesex County for utility work.

Beginning at 8 p.m., Tuesday, September 7 until 6 a.m. the next day, and continuing daily, Monday through Friday, for approximately two weeks, the Middlesex Water Company is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 35 northbound between Kelly Street and Walter Drive near the railroad tracks for the installation of a new water main. At least one lane will be maintained overnight.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
