## Route 124 westbound right lane closure required for bridge maintenance repairs in Springfield, Union County Closure required for temporary support installation

**(Trenton)** - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that a long-term lane closure is required on Route 124/Springfield Avenue westbound for maintenance work in Springfield, Union County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Thursday, September 23, and continuing for approximately three weeks, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction, is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 124/Springfield Avenue westbound between Valley Street and the entrance onto I-78 westbound/Clinton for bridge maintenance repairs. All exit ramps will remain open.

Upon completion of work on the westbound side, Route 124/Springfield Avenue eastbound will be closed for approximately two months.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
