## I-80 westbound lane closures required this weekend for priority repairs in Paterson Closures required to repair collapsed drainage pipe

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced weekend lane closures on I-80 westbound for priority repairs in Paterson, Passaic County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 24 until 5 a.m. Monday, September 27, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close three lanes on I-80 westbound just past Exit 58 – Madison Ave/Paterson/Clifton. This closure will allow the contractor to repair a collapsed drainage pipe under the roadway. At least one lane of westbound traffic will be maintained at all times.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
