Route 24 westbound Exit 9A to Broad Street to close tonight for deck spall repairs in Summit, Union County Signed detour will be in place

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 24 westbound Exit 9A to Broad Street will be closed and detoured tonight for deck spall repairs in Summit, Union County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Monday, September 27 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, September 28, NJDOT's contractor is scheduled to close the Route 24 westbound Exit 9A to Broad Street in Summit, Union County. This closure will allow the contractor to repair deck spall on the Exit ramp. Motorists will be directed to stay left on the ramp and follow the signed detour using Route 124 eastbound and U-turn back to Broad Street.
