Route 87 Bridge daytime lane closures next week for deck and joint repairs in Atlantic County

One lane in each direction will be closed between Atlantic City and Brigantine

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 87 Bridge between Atlantic City and Brigantine is scheduled to have one lane closed in each direction next week for deck and joint repairs in Atlantic County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. Monday, October 4 and continuing until 5 p.m. Thursday, October 7, NJDOT's contractor PKF Mark III, will closed one lane in each direction on the Route 87 Bridge between Atlantic City and Brigantine for bridge deck and joint repairs. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained.

NJDOT will be using Variable Message Signs to provide advance notification to motorists of traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
