## I-78 westbound lane closures needed for emergency shoulder work near Bridge over Raritan River in Bedminster, Somerset County Expect heavy congestion and major delays during the evening commute

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on I-78 westbound before the Bridge over North Branch of Raritan River for emergency shoulder work in Bedminster, Somerset County.

At approximately 6 a.m. this morning, Wednesday, October 13, all lanes on I-78 westbound were closed between I-287 and Exit 26/Rattlesnake Bridge Road, as well as the ramps from I-287 to I-78 westbound, due to an overturned tractor trailer. The left lane and the ramps from I-287 to I-78 westbound were reopened at approximately 11:30 a.m. The center and right lanes will remain closed to allow for emergency repairs to the expand the width of the shoulder on I-78 westbound near the Bridge over the North Branch of the Raritan River in Bedminster. One lane will be maintained. The work is expected to be completed tonight.

## The lane closures will continue through the evening commute. Motorists should expect heavy congestion and major delays and should consider alternate routes.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
