Route 1 northbound ramp to I-295 northbound to be closed overnight for concrete repairs in Mercer County Signed detour will be in place

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Route 1 northbound to I-295 northbound will be closed and detoured overnight for concrete repairs in Lawrence Township, Mercer County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, November 16 until 5 a.m. Wednesday, November 17, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the ramp from Route 1 northbound to I-295 northbound in Lawrence Township. This closure will allow the contractor to complete concrete repairs to the ramp. The following detour will be in place:

Route 1 northbound ramp to I-295 northbound detour:

- Motorists wishing to take the Route 1 northbound ramp to I-295 will be directed to continue on Route 1 northbound
- Take the exit for CR 533 North/Province Line Road/Nassau Park Boulevard
- Take the ramp onto Route 1 southbound
- Take the ramp onto I-295 northbound
