Route 70 eastbound ramp to Medford Leas Way daytime closures next week for basin restoration in Medford Signed detour will be in place during closure

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced daytime closures next week of the Route 70 eastbound ramp to Medford Leas Way for a basin restoration project in Medford, Burlington County. This work was originally scheduled to take place on Thursday and Friday, December 16 and 17.

From 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. on Monday, December 20, and Tuesday, December 21, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction Company, is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 70 eastbound to Medford Leas Way. The ramp will open to traffic at the end of each workday. This closure will allow the contractor to restore the retention basin. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 70 eastbound ramp to Medford Leas Way detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 70 eastbound wishing to take the ramp to Medford Leas
 Way will be directed to continue on Route 70 eastbound
- Take the traffic circle at the intersection of Route 70 and Route 206 to Route 70 westbound and Medford Leas Way intersection
