## Landing Lane Bridges over Raritan River/D&R Canal to reopen Friday in New Brunswick Final paving to take place this week

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Landing Lane Bridges over the Raritan River and Delaware & Raritan Canal connecting Piscataway and New Brunswick, Middlesex County will reopen Friday, December 17.

NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to finish the final paving of the bridge deck and approaches over the next few days. This work follows the completion of emergency repairs to the bridge superstructure and deck, as well as utility relocation. The two Landing Lane Bridges are expected to reopen after the evening commute on Friday, December 17. If the work is completed sooner, the bridges will reopen earlier. These repairs were necessary to prevent further deterioration and allow the continued safe operation of the existing bridges. A full-scale replacement project is in design and expected to go to construction in 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
