Route 33 bridge over Conrail railroad closed for emergency repairs in Monmouth County Traffic will be detoured during repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the closure and detour of Route 33 for emergency repairs to the Business Bridge over Conrail railroad in Freehold, Monmouth County.

At approximately 5:00 p.m. today, Wednesday, December 22, the Route 33 bridge over Conrail railroad between Valero and Weaser's Ices will be closed for emergency structure repairs. Route 33B will be closed and detoured at the bridge location for approximately three days. The following detours will be in place:

Route 33B Detour:

- Motorists wishing to continue on Route 33B should continue on Route 33B to Halls Mill Road
- Turn right onto Halls Mill Road
- Take the ramp to Route 33 westbound
- Turn right onto Route 79N/South Street
- Turn right onto Route 33B

Variable Message Signs will be used to provide advance notification to motorists. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
