Raritan Street closed for emergency repairs to the bridge carrying Route 9 over Raritan Street in South Amboy Repairs expected to be completed before morning commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that Raritan Street is closed for emergency repairs to the bridge carrying Route 9 over the street in South Amboy, Middlesex County.

At approximately 4:30 p.m., Wednesday, January 5, Raritan Street was closed and detoured to repair loose concrete falling from the bridge carrying Route 9 over the street. Route 9 remains open. Motorists on Raritan Street are being directed onto Route 9, where they can take the next exit to make a U-turn back to the Raritan Street exit. The work is expected to be completed before the morning commute tomorrow, Thursday, January 6.
