I-287 southbound right lane and ramp closure Friday night to remove steel pole in Piscataway Exit 6 to Washington Avenue detoured overnight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the closure of the right lane and Exit 6 on I-287 southbound to remove a steel pole in Piscataway, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tomorrow, Friday, February 11, until 5 a.m. Saturday, February 12, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, is scheduled to close the right lane on I-287 southbound and detour the Exit 6 ramp to Washington Avenue in Piscataway. The lane and ramp closure are necessary to remove a 75-foot steel pole. The following detour will be in place:

I-287 southbound Exit detour:

- Motorists on I-287 southbound wishing to take Exit 6 will be directed to continue on I-287 southbound
- Take Exit 5 for Stelton Road
- Turn right on Stelton Road
- Turn right on Centennial Avenue back to S. Washington Ave
