Route 4/Broadway Avenue eastbound shoulder to be closed Friday in Fair Lawn Electrical work requires overnight detour of Midland Avenue/Route 67

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced an overnight closure tonight of Route 4/Broadway Avenue eastbound shoulder near Midland Avenue/Route 67 in Fair Lawn, Bergen County.

Beginning at 8 p.m., tonight, Friday, April 22 until 6 a.m., Saturday, April 23, NJDOT's contractor, Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close the right lane and shoulder on Route 4/Broadway Avenue eastbound near Midland Avenue/Route 67. In addition, Midland Avenue/Route67 southbound is scheduled to be closed, between Route 4/Broadway Avenue and the Urgent Care driveway, starting at 10 p.m. The closure is necessary for electrical work. Local access will be maintained for residents and businesses. This work is scheduled to continue next Friday, April 29, at the same times. The following signed detours will be in place:

Route 4/Broadway Avenue eastbound to Midland Avenue/Route 67 southbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 4/Broadway Avenue eastbound wishing to turn right onto Midland Avenue/Route 67 southbound will be directed to continue on Route 4/Broadway eastbound
- Turn right onto Plaza Road
- · Turn right onto Ellington Road
- Turn left onto Midland Avenue/Route 67

The utility work is a part of a \$8.7 million project to better the driving conditions on Route 4/Broadway Avenue. The project is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2022.
