## I-80 eastbound ramp to I-280 eastbound to be closed tonight for milling in Parsippany-Troy Hills

**Closures required for pavement preservation** 

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the I-80 eastbound local ramp to I-280 eastbound will be closed tonight for milling in Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County.

Beginning at 11 p.m. tonight, Friday, April 29, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, April 30, NJDOT's contractor, Schifano Construction Corp., is scheduled to close and detour the I-80 eastbound local Exit 47A ramp to I-280 eastbound. The closure is necessary for milling. The pavement preservation work is schedule to continue in the coming weeks. NJDOT will provide more information before any future ramp closures are scheduled. The following detour will be in place:

## I-80 eastbound local Exit 47A ramp to I-280 eastbound detour:

- Motorists on I-80 eastbound local wishing to take Exit 47A to I-280 eastbound will be directed to continue on I-80 eastbound
- Take Exit 47B to Route 46 eastbound
- Take Route 46 eastbound to New Road
- Turn right onto New Road
- Take the ramp to I-280 eastbound

The work is part of the \$5.5 million federally-funded I-80, Beverwyck Road (CR 637) to Route 23 pavement preservation project to make repairs at various locations in Morris, Essex, and Passaic counties. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
