Route 37 westbound lane closures begin Monday for priority bridge repairs in Toms River, Ocean County Route 37 eastbound traffic will not be affected

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on the Route 37 westbound Tunney Bridge for priority deck repairs in Toms River, Ocean County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. Monday, June 13, until 4 p.m. and continuing daily, Monday through Thursday, until Thursday, June 23, NJDOT's contractor, PKF-Mark III, Inc., is scheduled to close the two right lanes on the Route 37 westbound Tunney Bridge for priority bridge deck repairs. Route 37 eastbound Mathis Bridge traffic will not be affected.

This work is part of a \$9.6 million statewide Drawbridge Preventative Maintenance Contract. Variable messaging signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the motoring public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
