Manhattan Avenue closed tonight between JFK Boulevard and Tonnele Avenue/Route 1&9 in Jersey City Expect congestion on Route 1&9 overnight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Manhattan Avenue will be closed tonight between JFK Boulevard and Tonnele Avenue/Route 1&9 in Jersey City.

Beginning at 7:30 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, July 13 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, July 14, Manhattan Avenue is scheduled to be closed and detoured between JFK Boulevard and Tonnele Avenue/Route 1&9. Motorists should expect congestion on Tonnele Avenue/Route 1&9. Local police will be assisting with traffic management. The following detours will be in place overnight:

Route 1&9 northbound to Manhattan Avenue eastbound detour

- Motorists on Route 1&9 northbound wishing to turn right onto Manhattan Avenue will be directed to continue on Route 1&9 northbound
- Turn right onto Secaucus Road
- Turn right onto JFK Boulevard
- Turn left onto Manhattan Avenue

Route 1&9 southbound to Manhattan Avenue eastbound detour

- Motorists on Route 1&9 southbound using the County Road jughandle to Manhattan Avenue eastbound will be directed to turn left onto Route 1&9 northbound
- Turn right onto Secaucus Road
- Turn right onto JFK Boulevard
- Turn left onto Manhattan Avenue

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
