I-295 lane closure tomorrow as painting project begins on bridge over Rancocas Creek in Burlington County I-295 northbound left shoulder will remain closed for approximately two months

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a lane closure on I-295 northbound over Rancocas Creek as a bridge painting maintenance project begins in Mount Laurel, Burlington County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, July 27, until 3 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, PFK-Mark III, will close the left lane on I-295 northbound over Rancocas Creek to place construction barriers and create a work zone in the left shoulder. The left shoulder will remain closed for approximately three months while NJDOT's contractor, Commodore Maintenance, Inc., conducts sandblasting and painting operations.

The project is part of a \$27 million federally-funded bridge painting contract to perform preventative maintenance on bridges statewide.
