## I-80 daytime lane closures next week needed for retaining wall field investigation in Knowlton Expect possible congestion during the morning commute

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on I-80 westbound before the S-curve are scheduled for next week.

## Monday, August 1

On Monday, August 1 (from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m.), NJDOT will be closing the <u>right lane</u> on I-80 westbound just before the S-curve near mile post 0.8 through mile post 1.7. One lane will remain open.

## Tuesday, August 2

On Tuesday, August 2 (from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m.), NJDOT will be closing the <u>left lane</u> on I-80 westbound just before the S-curve near mile post 0.8 through mile post 1.7. One lane will remain open.

The closures are necessary to conduct a field investigation as part of the Preliminary Engineering phase for an upcoming retaining wall project. Motorists are advised to slow down and use caution when driving through the work zone.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
