## Route 47 road closure and detour this week as culvert repair project continues in Millville, Cumberland County Detours will be in place during closure

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 47 will be closed and detoured in both directions this week as a culvert repair project continues in Millville City, Cumberland County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, August 9, until 11:59 p.m., Thursday, August 11, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction Co., is scheduled to close and detour Route 47 in both directions between Kates Boulevard and Maylin Street to install a diversion pipe as part of the Culvert Repair over Petticoat Branch project. The following detours will be in place:

## Route 47 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 47 northbound will be directed to turn right onto Kates Boulevard
- Turn left onto South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
- Turn left onto Maylin Street
- Turn right onto Route 47

## **Route 47 southbound detour:**

- Motorists on Route 47 southbound will be directed to turn left onto Maylin Street
- Turn right onto South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
- Turn right onto Kates Boulevard
- Turn left onto Route 47

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
