I-80 westbound daytime lane closure tomorrow needed for survey work in Knowlton Motorists advised to slow down and use caution in work zone

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today are reminding motorists of a lane closure on I-80 westbound before the S-curve tomorrow in Knowlton, Warren County.

On Tuesday, August 23 from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., NJDOT is scheduled to close the right lane on I-80 westbound just before the S-curve near mile post 1.7 through mile post 0.8. One lane will remain open. The closure is needed to conduct survey work for an upcoming project. Motorists are advised to slow down and use caution when driving through the work zone.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
