Route 46 eastbound ramp to Terrace Avenue to be closed and detoured tonight in Hasbrouck Heights Closures required for pavement preservation

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 46 eastbound ramp to Terrace Avenue will be closed tonight for pavement preservation in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, September 7, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, September 8, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the Route 46 eastbound ramp to Terrace Avenue. The closure is necessary for milling and paving. Motorists are advised to follow the posted detour.

The \$8.8 million federally-funded Route 46, Bergen Boulevard to Main Street roadway improvement project will resurface approximately two miles of Route 46 in Lodi, Hasbrouck Heights, and Teterboro, Bergen County. The project also includes the installation of ADA-compliant curbs and ramps, as well as traffic signal and guiderail upgrades. The project is expected to be complete in summer 2022.
