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Route 46 westbound ramp to I-80 westbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Knowlton, Warren County Overnight closures required for concrete deck repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the Route 46 westbound ramp to I-80 westbound will be closed and detoured tonight for concrete deck repairs in Knowlton, Warren County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 16, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, September 17, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction Co., Inc., is scheduled to close the Route 46 westbound ramp to I-80 westbound to make concrete deck repairs. The ramp from Route 94 northbound to I-80 eastbound will remain open during construction. The following detour will be in place:

Route 46 westbound ramp to I-80 westbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 46 westbound wishing to take the ramp to I-80 westbound/Delaware Water Gap/Stroudsburg, PA will be directed to stay right to take the ramp to Route 94 northbound/Blairstown
- Stay left to take the U-Turn to I-80 eastbound/Route 46
- Stay right to take the ramp to I-80 westbound/Delaware Water Gap/Stroudsburg, PA
- Stay right to take the ramp to I-80 westbound/All Trucks over 4 Tons
- Turn left to take the ramp to I-80 westbound

The work is part of a \$21.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
