## Route 46 westbound ramp to Green Street to be closed and detoured tonight in Teterboro Green Street ramps to Route 46 westbound also closed tonight

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Green Street ramps to Route 46 westbound will be closed tonight for pavement preservation work in Teterboro, Bergen County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, September 20, until 11:59 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the Route 46 westbound ramp to Green Street. In addition, beginning at 11:59 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, September 20, until 6:00 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, September 21, the Green Street ramps to Route 46 westbound will be closed and detoured. The closures are necessary for milling and paving. The following detours will be in place:

## Route 46 westbound ramp to Green Street/Hackensack Shopping Center detour:

- Motorists on Route 46 westbound wishing to take the ramp to Green Street/Hackensack Shopping Center will be directed to continue on Route 46 westbound
- Stay right to take the ramp to Route 17 northbound/Paramus
- Stay right to take the ramp to Polifly Road/I-80 eastbound/Hackensack
- Turn right to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound
- Stay right to take Exit 65 to Green Street/Teterboro/South Hackensack
- Turn right onto North Street back to Green Street

## Green Street northbound to Route 46 westbound detour:

- Motorists on Green Street northbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 46 westbound will be directed to continue on Green Street northbound
- Turn right onto North Street
- Turn right onto Huyler Street
- Turn right onto Route 46 westbound

## Green Street southbound to Route 46 westbound detour:

- Motorists on Green Street southbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 46 westbound will be directed to turn left onto North Street, which is before the ramp
- Turn right onto Huyler Street
- Turn right onto Route 46 westbound

The \$8.8 million federally-funded Route 46, Bergen Boulevard to Main Street roadway improvement project will resurface approximately two miles of Route 46 in Lodi, Hasbrouck Heights, and Teterboro, Bergen County. The project also includes the installation of ADA-

compliant curbs and ramps, as well as traffic signal upgrades. The project is expected to be complete in summer 2022.
