## Route 4/Broadway Avenue lane closure tonight in both directions to shift traffic in Elmwood Park Traffic shift necessary for median work

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures tonight on Route 4/Broadway Avenue in both directions between 54<sup>th</sup> Street and East Whitehall Street in Elmwood Park, Bergen County.

Beginning at 8 p.m., tonight, Friday, October 21 until 6 a.m., Saturday, October 22, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close the left lane in both directions on Route 4/Broadway Avenue between 54<sup>th</sup> Street and East Whitehall Street in Elmwood Park to install construction barrier to implement a traffic shift. One lane will be maintained overnight.

By 6 a.m. Saturday morning, traffic will be shifted to the right in both directions, using the shoulder as a travel lane. This configuration is expected to be in place for two weeks and is necessary to make median and guiderail improvements.

The work is a part of a \$8.7 million pavement preservation and traffic signal improvement project to improve driving conditions on Route 4/Broadway Avenue between River Drive in Elmwood Park and Tunbridge Road in Fair Lawn. The project is scheduled to be completed in early 2024.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
