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Route 3 westbound lane and ramps to and from Grove Street closed tonight in Clifton, Passaic County

Closure necessary for milling and paving

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and ramp closures on Route 3 westbound tonight as the Route 3/Route 46 Interchange Improvement Project advances in Clifton, Passaic County.

Route 3 westbound ramps to and from Grove Street closure

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, October 21 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday October 22, NJDOT's contractor, Union Paving & Construction Co., Inc., is scheduled to close the two right lanes on Route 3 from Broad Street through the Route 46 overpass. In addition, the Route 3 westbound ramps to and from Grove Street will be closed and detoured in Clifton. The closures are necessary for milling and paving. The following detours will be in place:

Route 3 westbound ramp to Grove Street detour:

- Motorists wishing to take the Route 3 westbound ramp to Grove Street will be directed to continue on Route 3 westbound and stay to the right
- Route 3 westbound becomes Route 46 westbound
- Take the exit for Great Notch Road/CR 709 east
- Turn right onto Valley Road southbound
- Turn left to take the ramp to Route 3 eastbound
- Take the exit for Grove Street

Grove Street ramp to Route 3 westbound detour:

- Motorists wishing to take the Grove Street ramp to Route 3 westbound will be directed to take the ramp to Route 3 eastbound
- Take the exit for Broad Street
- Turn left onto Broad Street
- Turn right onto Allwood Road
- Take the ramp to Route 3 westbound

The \$189 million federally-funded Contract B portion of the Route 3, Route 46, Valley Road and Notch/Rifle Camp Road Interchange Improvements project_includes the realignment and widening of Route 46, as well as the construction of wider shoulders, acceleration, deceleration, and auxiliary lanes. At the Route 3/Route 46 interchange, a three lane Route 3 section will replace the existing

two lane connections, and Route 46 will be realigned to better converge with Route 3. The new interchange includes four new bridge structures, a new signalized intersection, and a new multi-lane roundabout. This work is anticipated to be complete in 2024.

Contract A, which was completed in fall 2019, included the construction the new Great Notch Road, a new bridge over Route 46 from Great Notch Road to Clove Road, three signalized intersections, and two single-lane roundabouts parallel to Route 46 westbound to remove local traffic from the state highway.
