I-80 overnight lane closures needed tonight in Knowlton Motorists advised to slow down and use caution in work zone

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures tonight on I-80 eastbound and westbound before the S-curve in Knowlton, Warren County.

Tonight, Wednesday, November 9 from 10 p.m. until 1 a.m. Thursday, November 10, the right lane on I-80 eastbound from mile post 1.2 to mile post 1.5 is scheduled to be closed. One lane will remain open overnight. If necessary, the right lane on I-80 eastbound in the same area will be closed Thursday, November 10 from 10 p.m. until 1 a.m. Friday, November 11.

Upon completion of work in the eastbound direction tonight, work will shift to the westbound direction. From 1 a.m. until 3 a.m. Thursday, November 10, the right lane on I-80 westbound from mile post 1.5 to mile post 1.2 is scheduled to be closed. One lane will remain open. If necessary, the right lane on I-80 westbound in the same area will be closed Friday, November 11 from 1 a.m. until 3 a.m.

The closures are needed to conduct pavement tests for upcoming projects. Motorists are advised to slow down and use caution when driving through the work zone.
