Route 4 eastbound right lane closure tonight for utility work in Englewood, Bergen County At least one lane of traffic will be maintained overnight

(Trenton) – The right lane on Route 4 eastbound will be closed underneath the Jones Road Bridge starting at 10 p.m. tonight, Thursday, November 10 until 5 a.m. Friday, November 11 in Englewood, Bergen County.

The right lane closure is necessary for utility work. At least two lane of traffic will be maintained overnight. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays while driving through the work zone, or plan an alternate route.

The \$20.7 million federally-funded project will replace the Jones Road Bridge over Route 4 in Englewood Bergen County. The new bridge will be approximately three feet higher to improve under-clearance issues on Route 4. Work is expected to be complete in the summer 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
