Route 19 northbound and southbound ramps to I-80 westbound to be closed tomorrow night in Paterson, Passaic County Closure necessary for bridge deck repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the ramp from Route 19 northbound to I-80 westbound and the ramp from Route 19 southbound to I-80 westbound are scheduled to be closed tomorrow night in Paterson, Passaic County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tomorrow, Friday, April 7 until 5 a.m. Saturday, April 8, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction Co., is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 19 northbound to I-80 westbound and the ramp from Route 19 southbound to I-80 westbound. The ramp closures are necessary to make bridge deck repairs to the I-80 westbound Bridge over Route 19. The following detours will be in place:

Route 19 northbound to I-80 westbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 19 northbound wishing to take the ramp to I-80 westbound will be directed to keep right and take the ramp to Grand Street
- Turn left onto Grand Street, which becomes Murray Avenue
- Turn left onto Nagel Street, which becomes Squirrelwood Road
- Keep right to take the ramp to I-80 westbound

Route 19 southbound (from Grand Street) to I-80 westbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 19 southbound wishing to take the ramp to I-80 westbound (from Grand Street) will be directed keep left to continue on Route 19 southbound
- Take the ramp to Valley Road/Clifton/Main Street
- Turn left onto Valley Road/CR 621
- Turn left onto the ramp to Route 19 northbound/I-80
- Take the exit for I-80 west/Grand Street
- Keep right to take the ramp to Grand Street
- Turn left onto Grand Street, which becomes Murray Avenue
- Turn left onto Nagel Street, which becomes Squirrelwood Road
- Keep right to take the ramp to I-80 westbound

The work is part of a \$22.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
