Route 9 southbound right lane closure beginning tonight in South Amboy and Sayreville, Middlesex County At least one lane of traffic will be maintained

(Trenton) – The right lane on Route 9 southbound is scheduled to be closed tonight and continuing into next week for concrete deck repairs in South Amboy and Sayreville, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, April 21, until 8 a.m. Tuesday, April 25, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 9 southbound on the Route 9 Bridge over Raritan Street. The closure is necessary to make concrete deck repairs to the bridge. The ramp to Raritan Street/Sayreville will remain open during construction, and at least one lane of traffic will be maintained overnight.

The work is part of a \$9.8 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout Central Jersey.
