Jones Road northbound to be closed on bridge over Route 4 next week in Englewood, Bergen County Jones Road ramp to Route 4 eastbound also to be closed

(Trenton) – Jones Road northbound is scheduled to be closed on the bridge over Route 4 next week as the bridge replacement project advances in Englewood, Bergen County. In addition, the Jones Road ramp to Route 4 eastbound will be closed and detoured during construction.

Jones Road Bridge over Route 4 Closure

From 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. Monday, June 5, and continuing daily through Friday, June 9, at the same times, NJDOT's contractor, J.F. Creamer and Son, is scheduled to close Jones Road northbound on the bridge over Route 4. The closure is necessary for bridge work. Alternating traffic will be maintained on Jones Road southbound during construction.

Jones Road ramp to Route 4 eastbound Closure

In addition, from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. Monday, June 5, and again on Tuesday, June 6, at the same times, the ramp from Jones Road to Route 4 eastbound will be closed and detoured for drainage work. The ramp from Route 4 eastbound to Jones will remain open during construction. The following detour will be in place:

Jones Road northbound to Route 4 eastbound detour:

- Motorists on Jones Road northbound will be directed to turn left onto Ridgeland Terrace
- Turn left onto Jones Road
- Turn right onto Kenwood Street
- Turn right onto Route 4 eastbound

Jones Road southbound to Route 4 eastbound detour:

- Motorists on Jones Road southbound will be directed to turn left onto Kenwood Street
- Turn right onto Route 4 eastbound

The \$20.7 million federally funded project will replace the Jones Road Bridge over Route 4 in Englewood, Bergen County. The new bridge will be approximately three feet higher to improve under-clearance issues on Route 4. Work is expected to be completed in summer 2025.
