## Route 18 remains closed and detoured in both directions due to a gas main break at Racetrack Road in East Brunswick Repairs are expected to go on through the day

**(Trenton)** – Route 18 remains closed in both directions between Cranbury Road and Rues lane/CR 617 for emergency construction to repair a gas main break at the intersection of Route 18 and Racetrack Road in East Brunswick, Middlesex County.

The roadway was closed at approximately 2 a.m. today, Tuesday, July 25 following a gas main break at the intersection of Route 18 and Racetrack Road in East Brunswick. Repairs are ongoing and are expected go on through the day. The following detours are in place:

## Route 18 northbound detour:

- Traffic on Route 18 northbound will be directed to turn right on Rues Lane/CR 617
- Turn left onto Old Bridge Turnpike/ CR 527
- Turn left onto Milltown Road
- Take ramp onto Route 18 northbound

## **Route 18 southbound detour:**

- Traffic on Route 18 southbound will be directed to take the ramp onto Cranbury Road
- Stay left and follow signs for Old Bridge/Spotswood/Cranbury
- Use the left lane to make a U-turn onto Cranbury South River Road
- Stay right to take ramp onto Summerhill Road/CR 613
- Turn left onto Rues Lane/CR 617
- Turn right onto Route 18 southbound
