Route 22 eastbound lane closures for emergency repairs to the Watchung Avenue Bridge over Route 22 in North Plainfield Repairs expected to go through the evening commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on Route 22 eastbound for emergency repairs to the bridge carrying Watchung Avenue over Route 22 in North Plainfield, Somerset County.

At approximately 3 p.m., today, Thursday, July 27, the left and center lanes will be closed to repair loose concrete under the bridge carrying Watchung Avenue over Route 22. Watchung Avenue will remain open. The work is expected to go through the evening commute and be completed tonight. Motorists are advised to use caution, slow down, and expect delays.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
