Route 130 southbound ramp to CR 613 eastbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Delran Township, Burlington County Ramp to remain closed until Monday for guiderail replacement

(Trenton) – The Route 130 southbound ramp to CR 613/Bridgeboro Street eastbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured tonight as a guiderail replacement project advances in Delran Township, Burlington County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, August 8, until 4 p.m. Monday, August 14, the Route 130 southbound ramp to CR 613/Bridgeboro Street eastbound is scheduled to be closed to construct a new parapet wall and install guiderail. Motorists will be directed to continue on Route 130 southbound and follow the posted detour.

This work is part of a \$4.5 million federally-funded project to replace guiderails on Route 55, Route 322, Route 38, Route 70 and Route 130 in Gloucester, Burlington, and Camden Counties. Roadway work associated with guiderail replacement may also include modifications to bridge parapets and median barriers; and concrete curb, sidewalk, and inlet work. This project is expected to be complete in August of 2024.
