Route 47 lane closures tonight as intersection improvement project advances in Vineland, Cumberland County Closures necessary to install traffic signal poles and mast arms

(Trenton) – Route 47 is scheduled to have overnight lane closures at West Park Avenue as an intersection improvement project advances in Vineland, Cumberland County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Thursday, November 16 until 6 a.m. Friday, November 17, and again on Friday and Monday nights at the same times, the right lanes on Route 47 northbound and southbound are scheduled to be closed at the West Park Avenue intersection. The closures are necessary to install traffic signal poles. In addition, 15-minute full traffic stops may be required each night between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. the following day to install traffic signal mast arms over the roadway.

The work is part of a \$4.1 million project that will improve five intersections in five towns --Galloway, Gloucester, Pennsauken, Delran, and Vineland. There are several safety improvements that will be made to the Route 47 and West Park Avenue intersection, including replacing all the traffic signals, new sidewalks with ADA-compliant curb ramps, pedestrian push buttons, countdown style pedestrian signal heads, underground conduit, wire, and junction boxes.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
