Commercial Vehicle Travel Restrictions Lifted on all Interstate highways as of 2 p.m. today, Tuesday, February 13 Motorists urged to use caution as road conditions can change quickly

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials announced the Commercial Vehicle Travel Restriction will be lifted effective at 2 p.m. today, Tuesday, February 13 for all highways.

All vehicles previously listed in the restriction are able to resume normal travel on the following highways in both directions:

- I-78 (entire length)
- I-80 (entire length)
- I-280 (entire length)
- I-287 (entire length)
- Route 440 (between I-287 to the Outer Bridge Crossing)
- I-195 (entire length)
- I-295 (Pennsylvania border/Scudder Falls Bridge to Exit 60 at I-195)

Interstate and State highways are generally in good condition, but with high winds and freezing temperatures this evening there is a potential for slippery roads and black ice. Crews will continue to clear and treat roads this afternoon and monitor conditions through the night to make sure roads remain in good condition. It is important to remember road conditions can change quickly.

NJDOT will be using Variable Message Signs throughout the storm to provide updates.
