Route 27 overnight lane closures begin tonight as paving project begins in Somerset and Middlesex counties At least one lane will remain open in both directions during construction

(Trenton) – Route 27 is scheduled to have lane closures beginning tonight as a paving project begins in Somerset and Middlesex counties.

Starting at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, May 6 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, May 7, and continuing Monday through Friday at the same times for approximately two months, single lane closures are scheduled on Route 27 in both directions between Cardinal Court in South Brunswick and Veronica Avenue, Franklin Township/How Lane, New Brunswick. The closures are necessary for milling and paving.

The work is part of a \$10.1 million state-funded maintenance project to make roadway repairs in Mercer, Middlesex, and Somerset counties. Work includes milling and paving, and curb and inlet reconstruction. Work is expected to be complete summer of 2024.
