## Route 130/206 southbound lane closures tonight for overhead sign work in Bordentown, Burlington County Work to begin at Route 1 and move toward Delaware River

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced two lanes on Route 130/206 southbound are scheduled to be closed tonight for overhead sign work in Bordentown, Burlington County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, May 8 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, May 9, the two left lanes on Route 130/206 southbound are scheduled to be closed just past Elizabeth Street in Bordentown where the two roadways merge. The closures are necessary to remove the overhead sign to install new brackets and reinstall the sign.

Variable Message Signs will provide advance notification to motorists of traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
