I-295 northbound lane closure tonight in Bellmawr, Camden County Closures necessary for guiderail repair

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the right lane on I-295 northbound is scheduled to be closed tonight for guiderail repair as the Direct Connection project advances in Bellmawr, Camden County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, May 10 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, May 11, the right lane on I-295 northbound will be closed after the old Exit 26/new Exit 27A (left exit) for guiderail and attenuator repair. At least one lane will be maintained.

The work is part of the Direct Connection project that will provide a seamless route for I-295 motorists traveling through the interchange of I-295, I-76, and Route 42. Portable variable message signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
