To discuss the I-80
Rockfall Mitigation
Project

The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is committed to developing roadway transportation improvements that balance transportation needs, the environment, community concerns and costs. The purpose of the I-80 Rockfall Mitigation Project is to increase safety and improve the mobility of the traveling public by preventing rockfall incidents. This I-80 segment, between mileposts 1.04 and 1.45, has been continually ranked with the highest rockfall hazard rating score (i.e., highest risk) in New Jersey based on the Federal Highway Administration's Rockfall Hazard Rating System.

Federal regulations require the NJDOT to take into account the effect of proposed projects upon historic resources listed in or eligible for the National Register of Historic Places, referred to as the "Section 106 Process." As part of the process, the public is encouraged to provide input. Historic preservation organizations, historical societies, and similar groups, or individuals having pertinent information about cultural resources in the project area are encouraged to attend.
