POST THIS PERS STATE MEMBER NOTICE IN A PUBLIC AREA AT THE WORKPLACE

- At its meeting on February 26, 2019, the Board of Trustees of the PERS deemed Thomas Bruno elected to a three-year term as State Representative to the PERS Board effective July 1, 2019.
- Mr. Bruno was the only candidate to obtain 500 or more eligible PERS State member nominations online or by paper petition. Therefore, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:2-1.4, the PERS Board noted that Mr. Bruno is elected to the State Representative position without balloting.
- Mr. Bruno is retired from the Hunterdon Developmental Center. This is his fifth three-year term as a representative on the PERS Board of Trustees. Mr. Bruno serves as Chairperson on the PERS Board.
