The NJDPB is proud to announce the launch of our newly redesigned website and brand identity. When you go to the NJDPB website at www.nj.gov/treasury/pensions on March 1, 2018, you will see a fresh, updated design that was created with the user's needs in mind.

Our goal was to create a clean, modern look and provide our clients with easy, streamlined navigation on a well-organized website. Visitors to our website will notice three distinct choices on our homepage: Active Employees, Retirees, and Employers. Secondary selections for either Pensions or Health Benefits information will allow users to quickly reach the information they are seeking. In addition, we have created a "Life Events" tab that will make reporting a life change to the NJDPB a more straightforward process (e.g., an address or name change, notification of death, a change in dependent status, etc.).

In addition to altering the look and navigation of the NJDPB website, we have created a video library that provides members with short, easy to understand videos regarding pensions, health benefits, and our brand story. Members can also make an appointment to see a counselor, search for webinars, or register for the Member Benefits Online System (MBOS) with just a few clicks of the mouse with our Services option.
