New Jersey State Income Tax Deadline Extended For Storm Victims

TRENTON -- The New Jersey Department of the Treasury announced today that the State's Division of Taxation will follow the Internal Revenue Service's two-day extension of the filing deadline for those state income tax returns due April 17. Returns and payments postmarked or received by April 19, 2007 will be considered timely filed.

For the purposes of this extension, affected taxpayers include individuals located in flooded areas, as well as those whose tax records, including documents needed for making tax deposits, are located in those areas. The transmission of returns and remittances that are submitted electronically must be completed by midnight, April 19, in order to avoid applicable penalties. Paper submissions must be postmarked by that date as well. Those filing paper submissions should write "APRIL 16 STORM" in ink at the top of the form in order to be considered for this tax relief.
